
ANONYMOUS ONLINE SAFETY REPORTING FORM

In case you are unsure where your child's classroom is in September, here is a reminder of our school layout.



ESSENTIAL FOR ALL YEAR GROUPS

- ★ All belongings to be clearly labelled with pupil's name
- An appropriate coat for the weather conditions
- Small rucksack (A4 size) or drawstring bag to be brought in every day
- ★ Water bottles to be brought daily (containing water only please)
- ★ School uniform full details on our website under Parents/school uniform tab.

SCHOOL EQUIPMENT LIST

Key Stage 1

- Book Bags to be brought in daily
- ★ PE kit to be stored in a drawstring bag and left in school. to include black shorts, black jogging bottoms, t-shirt in house colour and sports trainers

Year 3 & 4

- ★ A piece of fruit or vegetable for morning snack to be brought daily
- A small pencil case including essential items only (no novelty/distracting stationery)

 Items to include black handwriting/gel pen (no biros please), writing pencils, rubber, pencil sharpener, glue stick, ruler and a small selection of colouring pencils
- ***Children to wear PE kit to school*** on the 2 days each week when the class have PE (please check year group webpage or ask class teacher for PE days)

 Year 3 & 4 PE Kit Light grey hoodie (either school logo or plain), house team coloured t–shirt, black jogging bottoms or shorts (plain no stripes etc very small emblem acceptable no leggings or football club shorts please), sports trainers (no daps), deodorant (no aerosols), no red school jumpers on PE days for hygiene reasons

Year 5 & 6

- ★ A piece of fruit or vegetable for morning snack to be brought daily
- A small pencil case including essential items only (no novelty/distracting stationery) ltems to include black handwriting pen, writing pencils, rubber, pencil sharpener, glue stick, ruler and a small selection of colouring pencils
- ★ Year 5 & 6 PE Kit Light grey Hoodie (either school logo or plain), house team coloured t-shirt, black jogging bottoms or shorts (plain no stripes etc very small emblem acceptable no football club shorts or leggings), sports trainers (no daps), deodorant (no sprays), no black or red school jumpers for hygiene reasons on PE days
- ***Children to wear PE kit to school*** on the 2 days each week when the class have PE (see year group webpage or speak to class teacher for PE days)
- ★ Complete permissions slips, available on the school website under Parents/forms tabs, for your child to walk home and bring a mobile phone to school (if required). To be returned via email to office@haydonleighschool.co.uk. No child will be allowed to walk home unless the form has been completed.
