LOST PROPERTY


Please check with your child's teacher if your child is missing any uniform as there is lots of unclaimed uniform/water bottles etc in the cloakrooms.

Any request for leave must be made in writing. A response will be returned indicating whether the leave is authorised. <u>Any absence not authorised may be liable to a local authority penalty notice.</u>
